

REGULAR MEETING OF THE BURBANK CITY COUNCIL FEBRUARY 13, 2019

CALL TO ORDER	The meeting of February 13, 2019 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Dan M. Foy in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79 th Street Burbank, Il.
ROLL CALL	Mayor Foy requested a roll call which indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Barb Gagle, Alderwoman Sheri Gustafson, Alderman James Grider, Alderman John Pacella, Alderman Mitchell Piznarski, Alderman Jason Pyle, Mayor Dan M. Foy, Clerk Barry J. Szymczak, Treasurer Dean Viverito and City Attorney Vince Cainkar. Absent: Alderman Robert Contreras.
PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE	Mayor Foy asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.
JOURNAL	Alderman James Grider made a motion seconded by Alderwoman Gagle to approve the minutes of January 23, 2019. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
CURRENT BILLS	Alderman Grider then made a motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to approve the current list of bills. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
CLERK'S REPORT	On January 18 th , Clerk Szymczak attended a bid opening at City Hall in reference to the purchase of specialized vehicle exhaust removal equipment systems for the Burbank Fire Department. The following companies submitted bids:

CITIZEN'S REPORT The Chair recognized Frank Pryztula 8503 S. Oak Park Ave. who commented on the removal of recycling bins at St. Albert the Great Parish and St. Louis de Montfort Parish. Mr. Pryztula also commented on the pending legislation on abolishing townships within the State of Illinois.

The Chair then recognized Ed Mazurek of 87th & McVickers who raised concern about the ongoing truck traffic and noise at the construction site of the reservoir on 87th Street.

The Chair invited Council members and audience to inspect the new fire ambulances, heart monitors and new Public Works truck which would be on display after the Council meeting on the Fire Department Apparatus floor.

The Chair then invited anyone from Reavis High School to have their government class forms signed at the adjournment of the Council Meeting.
