CALL TO ORDER	The meeting of May 25, 2022 was called to order by Mayor Dan M. Foy at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79 th Street Burbank, II.
ROLL CALL	A roll call indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Barb Gagle, Alderman Robert Contreras, Alderwoman Sheri Gustafson, Alderman Claude Haerr, Alderman John Pacella, Alderman Mitchell Piznarski, Alderman Thomas Phillips, Mayor Dan M. CITY ENGINEER REPORT	No report was filed for this meeting. Mayor Foy suggested that a yearly small sidewalk replacement project is under consideration after estimates could be reviewed.

Martin Vasquez received the Police Award and Bat. Chief Robert Brown was the recipient of the Fire Department Award.
