

REGULAR MEETING OF THE BURBANK CITY COUNCIL DECEMBER 20, 2023

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of December 20, 2023 was called to order by Mayor Dan M. Foy at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, II.

ROLL CALL

Ald. Haerr made a motion seconded by Ald. Phillips to ask the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance for Dept. of Zoning, Planning and development Petition #23-11-1 Properties Investment Group LLC. 5900 W. 79th St. Burbank, II. requesting special use for a drive-up window which was approved by Zoning with a 2/3 vote. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Ald. Gagle, Ald. Contreras, Ald. Gustafson, Ald. Haerr, Ald. Pacella, Ald. Piznarski and Ald. Phillips. Mayor Foy asked the property owner, who was in attendance, about perspective business interests at the location. He said he is in negotiations with a coffee shop at the present time and demolition could start by March 2024.

Ald. Haerr made a motion seconded by Ald. Gustafson to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Burbank and the Illinois Council of Police referencing a 12 hr. work schedule. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Ald. Gagle, Ald. Contreras, Ald. Gustafson, Ald. Haerr, Ald. Pacella, Ald. Piznarski and Ald. Phillips.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

No reports were filed for this meeting.

POLICE DEPT. REPORT

Chief Garcia reported that year to date, his department has 1200 arrests, 158 investigations, 9000 citations issued, 581 vehicle tows, a \$10,000.00 grant towards the body camera program and the Department Accreditation Program is in progress. The Mayor and City Council thanked the Chief and his support staff for the diligent work they are performing.

FIRE DEPT. REPORT

Chief Gilgenberg reported the new fire engine is still about 5 months out for completion and all the other fire equipment has gone through preventative maintenance and is running at 100%.

BUILDING AND ZONING

Comm. Hession reported 14 contractor licenses, 64 building permits, including 1 new home construction, have been issued as of 12/20/23. He also reported that the hotel project at 79th & State Rd. has secured additional funding and work is to resume in early 2024.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT

Dir. Burris reported the new tree chipper is in service and his department has secured a grant from the Morton Arboretum for \$25,000.00 to \$150,000.00 a tree replacement and planting program.

CITY ENGINEER REPORT

City Engineer Geary reported that the roof projects have been completed with minor inspections to follow.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business brought before City Council.

NEW BUSINESS

Ald. Gustafson made a motion seconded by Ald. Contreras to approve payment of \$50,000.00, in 2 installments of \$25,000.00 each, first to be paid by the end of the fiscal year ending December 31st, and the 2nd to be paid in June 2024, to the Burbank Park District for joint sponsorship for the 2024 Burbank Party in the Park to be held June 27th through June 30th, 2024. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Ald. Gagle, Ald. Contreras, Ald. Gustafson, Ald. Haerr, Ald. Pacella, Ald. Piznarski and Ald. Phillips.

Ald. Gagle made a motion seconded by Ald. Haerr to promote Sgt. Manuel Escalante to the rank of Lieutenant with the Burbank Police Department. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Ald. Gagle, Ald. Contreras, Ald. Gustafson, Ald. Haerr, Ald. Pacella, Ald. Piznarski and Ald. Phillips. The candidate was sworn in by Fire-Police Commission Secretary Chris Wiest.

Ald. Gagle made a motion seconded by Ald. Piznarski to promote Patrol Officer Victor Villanueva to the rank of Sergeant with the Burbank Police Department. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Ald. Gagle, Ald. Contreras, Ald. Gustafson, Ald. Haerr, Ald. Pacella, Ald. Piznarski and Ald. Phillips.
