



**REGULAR MEETING

BURBANK CITY COUNCIL  
MAY 10, 2023**

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of May 10, 2023 was called to order by Mayor Dan M. Foy at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79<sup>th</sup> Street Burbank, Il.
- ROLL CALL** A roll call indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Barb Gagle (via Zoom), Alderman Robert Contreras, Alderwoman Sheri Gustafson, Alderman Claude Haerr, Alderman Mitchell Piznarski, Alderman Thomas Phillips, Mayor Dan M. Foy, Clerk Barry J. Szymczak and Treasurer Dave Viverito. Absent: Alderman John Pacella. Also in attendance: City Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** Mayor Foy asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- JOURNAL** Mayor Foy asked for a motion to approve the minutes of April 26, 2023. The motion was made by Alderman Contreras and seconded by Alderman Phillips with unanimous approval by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Mayor Foy then asked for a motion to approve the current list of bills. The motion was made by Alderman Contreras and seconded by Alderman Haerr. - ADMINISTRATION REPORT** Mayor Foy stated that the delay on the restaurant project on 79<sup>th</sup> & Lavergne is due to litigation because of the untimely passing of one of the partners. Also, the City Attorney is working with the Mosque on 80<sup>th</sup> & Central for use of parking space at the Old Barn property. He also reported that work on the Fire and Police Department properties are underway. Finally, the Mayor reported that sales at Starbuds have been doing extremely well.

The candidate was sworn in by Fire-Police Commission Secretary Chris Wiest. Mayor Foy read a brief biography.
