



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
JANUARY 14, 2015

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of January 14, 2015 was called to order by Mayor Harry Klein at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79th Street. Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Foy, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski, and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach, Treasurer Viverito, and Attorney Vince Cainkar. Absent: Alderman Looney
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Foy, to approve the minutes of December 17, 2014 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

Mayor Klein said when Bill Flaherty was in the same position as Alderman Szymczak was he would tell him that we do pay them every two weeks. Mayor Klein then invited the Reavis students in the audience to come up front after the meeting and have their government papers signed by anyone at the Council table or the front table.
