**CALL TO  
ORDER**

The meeting of May 11, 2016 was called to order at 7:30 pm. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers at 6530 W. 79<sup>th</sup> street in Burbank, Illinois.

**ROLL CALL**

Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski, Foy, Looney, and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Treasurer Viverito, Deputy Clerk Chisholm and Attorney Gary Perlman. Absent: Clerk Roach.

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the minutes of April 27, 2016 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pacella, Piznarski, Szymczak, Pyle, Foy, Looney, and Szymczak.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Grider approving **ORDINANCE # 8-5-16**, fixing a time and place for the public hearing on the City of Burbank downtown Burbank redevelopment project area, redevelopment project plan and tax increment allocation financing. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes, 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Looney, Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski, and Grider.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Pyle to approve **ORDINANCE #9-5-16**, providing for the acquisition of a portion of the property located at 7901 South Harlem Avenue for street and highway purposes. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes, 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Grider, Foy, Szymczak, Looney, Pacella, Pyle, and Piznarski.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Pacella to approve **ORDINANCE #10-5-16**, authorizing a variation to allow the construction of a six-foot front/side yard fence for the property located at 8601 South Lockwood. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes, 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pacella, Grider, Piznarski, Looney, Pyle, Szymczak, and Alderman Foy.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Szymczak to approve Intergovernmental Agreement between the South Stickney Sanitary District and the City of Burbank relative to the assignment of the lien at 5001 West 79<sup>th</sup> Street ( former Cezar's Inn site). A roll call indicated the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Szymczak, Looney, Pacella, Foy, Pyle, Grider, and Alderman Piznarski.
