**CALL TO
ORDER**

The meeting of May 10, 2017 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers at 6530 W. 79TH Street in Burbank, Illinois

Mayor Klein asked for a motion to approve an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement between the City of Burbank and the Village of Bridgeview pertaining to the 85th Street paving improvements from Harlem Ave. to Cicero Ave. The motion was made by Alderman Foy and seconded by Alderman Piznarski. A roll call vote indicate 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Aldermen Foy, Contreras, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Mayor Klein introduced Barbara Gagle and Sheri Lynn Gustafson as the new aldermen of the 1st and 3rd Wards respectfully. He then introduced the Honorable Peter Felice who presided over the swearing in of the candidates. Mayor Klein then introduced Alderman Barry Szymczak as the newly elected City Clerk. Judge Felice presided over the swearing in. Finally, Mayor Klein introduced Alderman Dan M. Foy as the newly elected Mayor of the City of Burbank.
