



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
MAY 24, 2017

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of May 24, 2017 was called to order at 7:30 PM. by Mayor Dan M. Foy in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present:
Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Piznarski, Alderman Pyle, Mayor Foy, Clerk Szymczak, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
Absent: Alderman Pacella.
- JOURNAL** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Pyle to approve the minutes of May 10, 2017. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
- CLERK'S REPORT** Clerk Szymczak reported that City Hall will be closed on Saturday May 27th and Monday May 29th in observance of the Memorial Day Holiday. The deadline for city stickers is Wednesday May 31st. The Clerk's Office will remain open until 7:30 PM that evening for the public's convenience. He also reported that a hearing was held on Tuesday May 23rd at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers regarding complaints received from the public about solicitors from Cannon Consulting representing Constellation Energy. Common complaints were misrepresentation of the individuals and pressure tactics, especially against the elderly. At the end of the hearing, Cannon Consulting agreed to voluntarily pull their soliciting permit from the City. "No Solicitors Invited" stickers are being handed out to the public with their city stickers for those who are interested and a program to automatically issue those decals along with all stickers will be implemented in 2018.
- DEPT. OF PUBLIC WORKS** Alderman Contreras made a motion seconded by Alderman Piznarski to authorize the attorney to prepare Ordinance #17-04-1 for Marcin & Monica Mietus 8521 South Nottingham Burbank, Il 60459. The petitioner is requesting a subdivision of 2 lots, (lot #1 – 50 X166.03) and (lot #2 – 49.97 X 166.03, 49.99 x 66.355), a variation on the lot width for lot #2. A roll call vote indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

Mayor Foy informed the gallery that the City will be adding a code enforcement officer to assist with blight complaints and other various code violations. This project will be overseen by Chief Shore and Alderwoman Gagle, Public Safety Chairwoman. The Mayor also reported that in reference to the Melvina Ditch Project, all the property has been acquired and that the project seems to be going along according to schedule.

**CITIZEN'S
REPORT**

The Chair recognized Charles Bandusky 8548 South Laverne who first wanted to congratulate Mayor Foy, Clerk Szymczak and Alderwomen Gagle and Gustafson on their new positions. He then wanted to inquire about the status of the property at 79th & Major. Mayor Foy told him plans were submitted for a Dunkin' Donuts and that the project is moving along. He then inquired about the property located at 87th & Mayfield, Firehouse Subs, which is scheduled to open June 12th and a prospective business possibly going into the strip mall property at 80th & Cicero. The Mayor informed Mr. Bandusky that all projects are still in the works.

The Chair then recognized Frank Pryztula 8503 South Oak Park Ave. who inquired about a blight and wild life problem in that area. Blight Officer Dave Wilson said he would look into the situation immediately.

The Chair then recognized a citizen from 7535 South Lockwood who was inquiring about the raising of pigeons in Burbank. She explained her situation and the Mayor, although being sympathetic, explained to her that there are ordinances prohibiting such actions.

The Chair then recognized Jerry Synoga 8109 South Normandy. His question was directed to Clerk Szymczak regarding people who already signed with Constellation Energy. The Clerk stated that he had no quarrel with Constellation and that the residents are free to sign up with any energy company that they are comfortable with. His concern was with the selling tactics of the sub-contracting solicitors. The citizens of Burbank should not and will not be subjected to such shady sales tactics.


