



REGULAR MEETING

SEPTEMBER 27, 2017

CALL TO ORDER The meeting of September 27, 2017 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Dan M. Foy in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, Illinois.

ROLL CALL Mayor Foy requested a roll call which indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski, Mayor Foy, Clerk Szymczak and Treasurer Viverito. Absent: Alderman Pyle.

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

JOURNAL Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the minutes of September 13, 2017. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

CURRENT BILLS Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to approve the current list of bills. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella and Alderman Piznarski.

Alderman Robert Contreras made a motion seconded by Alderman Gagle to authorize the Attorney to prepare an ordinance for Petition #17-08-1 Lorenzo Leos 8549 S. Lavergne Ave., Burbank, Il. For a variation to install a 6' privacy fence on a front yard side set back. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella and Alderman Piznarski. The 2 week waiting period was waived

Alderman Contreras then made a motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to authorize the Attorney to prepare an ordinance for Petition #17-08-2 Daniel and Araceli Aragon 8300 S. Latrobe Ave., Burbank, Il. For a variation to install a 6' privacy fence and a concrete patio on a front yard side set back. A roll call vote indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella and Alderman Piznarski. The 2 week waiting period was waived.

Alderman Piznarski made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to award Homer Tree Care, Inc. as low bidder for the 2017 EAB Tree Removal Program (MFT Section # 17-00000-00-GM) in the amount of \$40,367.29 which was nearly \$21,000.00 under Engineer's estimate.. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella and Alderman Piznarski.

Alderman Piznarski then made a motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to award Cargill Co. as low bidder for the 2018 Bulk Rock Salt Program in the amount of \$147,780.00. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella and Alderman Piznarski.

**CITIZENS
REPORT**

The Chair recognized Terry Hoy of 7859 South Natoma who had questions about recent soliciting in the area. Mayor Foy and Clerk Szymczak informed him that there are legal, licensed solicitors working in the Burbank area in regards to home improvement and electrical service. The Clerk also asked that Mr. Hoy stop at the Clerk's office to obtain "No Solicitors Welcome" stickers for his residence in the event it becomes a nuisance. Chief Shore added comments about a recent telephone scam operation which occurred recently.

The Chair then recognized a resident from 8844 South Nashville in Oak Lawn, IL, who had been protesting in front of City Hall within the past 3 weeks in reference to situations between the Building Dept. and himself. The Chair allowed him to voice his complaints and then assured him that he would be more than happy to meet with him after the adjournment of the meeting or on a date convenient to both sides.

Mayor Foy then invited any Reavis High School students to have their government class forms signed after the Council Meeting was adjourned.

There being no further business, the Chair asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Alderman Pacella and seconded by Alderwoman Gagle with unanimous voice approval and so declared by the Chair.
