



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 14, 2018

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of February 14, 2018 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Dan M. Foy in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Mayor Foy requested a roll call which indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski, Alderman Pyle, Mayor Foy, Clerk Szymczak, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- JOURNAL** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the minutes of January 24, 2018. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderwoman Gagle to approve the current list of bills. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
- CLERK'S REPORT** Clerk Szymczak reported that City Hall will be closed on Monday February 19th in observance of the Presidents Day holiday. Absentee ballot applications are available at the Clerk's Office for the March 20th Gubernatorial Election. Early voting will start February 21st at the Bridgeview Courthouse and March 5th at Prarie Trails Library.

- Mayor Foy introduced Pam Barnett from Stickney Township Animal Control who gave a brief report on the coyote situation in Burbank.
- Mayor Foy then introduced Tom Fagan representing Azavar Corp.who gave a report on the services his company will be providing the City in reference to sales tax collection from utility companies which are owed the City and to make sure they are properly coded as such.
- Mayor Foy then recognized the fine work that the Public Works Dept. headed by Director Bill Trovato did on snow removal throughout the City during the past week and a half.

OF ZONING** Alderman Robert Contreras made a motion seconded by Alderwoman Gustafson to adopt Ordinance # 3-2-18, a special use to allow the use and operation of a car wash facility located at 8400 South Cicero Ave. Burbank, Il. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

Alderman Contreras then made a motion seconded by Alderman Piznarski to ask to adopt Ordinance# 4-2-18 authorizing a variation to allow the construction of a 6' front/side yard fence for the property located at 8601 South Sayre Ave. Burbank, Il. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

Alderman Contreras then made a motion seconded by Alderman Grider to adopt Ordinance # 5-2-18 authorizing a variation to allow the construction of a 6' front/side yard fence for the property located at 8217 South Mayfield Ave. Burbank, Il. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

Alderman Contreras then made a motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to adopt Ordinance # 6-2-18 authorizing variation to install a 6" privacy fence on front/side yard fence for the property located at 4956 West 85th Place Burbank, Il. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

Alderman James Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to adopt Ordinance #2-2-18 approving the reservation of volume cap in connection with private activity bond issues and related matters. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

Mayor Foy then directed any students from Reavis H.S. to have their government class forms signed at the adjournment of the meeting.

There being no further business, the Chair asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Alderwoman Gustafson and seconded by Alderman Pyle with unanimous voice approval and so declared by the Chair.
