



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
JANUARY 10, 2018

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of January 10, 2018 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Dan M. Foy in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Mayor Foy requested a roll call which indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski, Alderman Pyle, Mayor Foy, Clerk Szymczak, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the minutes of December 20, 2017. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderwoman Gagle to approve the current list of bills. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
- DEPT. OF ADMINISTRATION** Mayor Foy asked for a motion to approve Resolution #1-1-18 authorizing a settlement agreement between the City of Burbank and Luke Oil, Inc. The motion was made by Alderman Contreras and seconded by Alderman Pyle. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
- Mayor Foy then asked for a motion to adopt a Proclamation for National School Choice Week / City of Burbank School Choice Week from January 21st to January 27th, 2018. The motion was made by Alderman Piznarski and seconded by Alderwoman Gagle. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
- DEPT. OF ZONING** Alderman Contreras asked for a motion seconded by Alderman Piznarski to adopt Ordinance #1-1-18 authorizing a special use to allow the use and operation of a tire shop facility located at 8409 South Harlem Ave. Burbank, Illinois. A roll call indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.

The Chair recognized Charles Bandusky 8548 South LaVergne who inquired about the status of the Crystal Banquet facility and the property at Caesar's Inn. Mayor Foy informed him that the banquet facility has already changed hands to make way for the new car wash and still no activity at Caesar's as of yet.

The Chair then recognized Dennis Murda 8358 South Sayre who inquired about the maintainence of the field located at 83rd Street and Sayre Ave. which is under the jurisdiction of Com Ed and the Village of Bridgeview. Mayor Foy informed Mr. Murda he would look into the lack of upkeeping of the property, especially snow removal on the sidewalks for the school children.

There being no further business, the Chair asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Alderman Grider and seconded by Alderman Contreras with unanimous voice approval and so declared by the Chair.
