**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting of January 22, 2020 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Dan M. Foy in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79<sup>th</sup> Street Burbank, IL.

**ROLL CALL**

Mayor Foy requested a roll call which indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Barb Gagle, Alderman Robert Contreras, Alderwoman Sheri Gustafson, Alderman John Pacella, Alderman Mitchell Piznarski, Alderman Jason Pyle, Mayor Dan M. Alderman Contreras made a motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to approve the minutes of January 8, 2020. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

Mayor Foy asked for a motion to appoint Claude Haerr as Alderman of the 4<sup>th</sup> Ward of the City of Burbank. Mr. Haerr will be serving the unexpired term of the late Alderman James Grider. The motion was made by Alderman Pyle and seconded by Alderwoman Gagle. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle. Mr. Haerr was sworn in by City Clerk Barry Szymczak. Mayor Foy read a brief biography.

Mayor Foy then asked for a motion to appoint Christopher Wiest as Commissioner to the Fire / Police Commission of the City of Burbank. Mr. Wiest will be serving the unexpired term of Commissioner Claude Haerr. The motion was made by Alderman Pacella and seconded by Alderman Piznarski. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle. Mr. Wiest was sworn in by City Clerk Barry Szymczak.

Mayor Foy introduced Randy Cohn of McDonald's who made a presentation to the winner of the fund-raising competition between St. Laurence and Reavis High Schools. The first place prize of \$1000.00 was awarded to Reavis High School and a runner-up prize of \$500.00 was awarded to St. Laurence High School.
