- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of March 27, 2013 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79th Street, Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Foy, Looney, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Treasurer Viverito, Clerk Roach and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the minutes of March 13, 2013 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills, A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Looney, Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski and Grider.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Szymczak to award the bid to the low bidder Crowley –Sheppard Asphalt for the 2013 Street Rehabilitation – Project No. 12239 Bid opening held March 19, 2013 for \$1,821,938.44. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pyle, Piznarski, Foy, Grider, Looney, Szymczak and Pacella.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Looney to award the bid for the 2013 CDBG Street Rehabilitation – CDBG project No. 12-004 bid opening held March 20, 2013 to the lowest bidder who is J. Nardulli Concrete for \$249,047.25. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Grider, Foy, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle, Pacella and Looney.

**CITIZEN'S
REPORT**

The Chair recognized Mr. Charles Bandusky of 8548 S. Lavergne who was concerned with the electrical aggregation program that it was similar with the Naperville project that they were going into the homes of residents. He was assured by the Mayor and the attorney that Naperville is unique and they are an electric company like Com Ed and that program is not here. No one will be going into the homes of Burbank residents.

The Chair recognized Mr. John Frega who said he is an architect and has worked on several projects in this area. He said he submitted drawings to the Building department 56 days ago and received a six page letter today from a consultant saying they had to work on the drawings. He said they would be happy to do this but hoped the City could expedite this permit. The Mayor said I assume you are referring to the project at the Township Highway department on 77th and Mason. Frank Kainrath said he would like to answer that and the Mayor said Frank he didn't say anything. Frank Kainrath said that Mr. Frega turned in an incomplete application. The Mayor told Mr. Frega to get whatever the City requires and that as soon as he turns that in he will get the permit immediately. Mr. Frega said he would like it by Friday and the Mayor said that was not going to happen as we were closed on Friday.
