



REGULAR MEETING

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of April 27, 2011 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, at 6530 W. 79th Street, Burbank, Illinois 60459.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following members present: Alderman Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar. Absent: Alderman Pollard and Alderman Foy.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the minutes of April 13, 2011 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Pacella to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 5 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pyle, Piznarski, Grider, Szymczak and Pacella.
- DEPT. OF PUBLIC WORKS** Motion made by Alderman Szymczak seconded by Alderman Pyle to approve MFT Resolution – **2011 Street Resurfacing No. 11-00047-00-RS in the amount of \$730,000 from MFT Engineering and Construction.** A roll call vote indicated 5 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Grider, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle and Pacella.
- DEPT. OF ZONING** Motion made by Alderman Szymczak seconded by Alderman Piznarski for the reappointment of Robert Schmidt, Zoning, Planning and Development Commission for the term of April 30, 2011 through April 29, 2014. A roll call vote indicated 5 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Piznarski and Grider.
- CITIZEN'S REPORT REPORT** The Chair recognized Mr. Charles Vandusky of 8548 Lavergne who gave two addresses for the blight officer to look at 4837 and 4827 W. 83rd street. Mayor Klein told him that the blight officer reports to the Director of Public Works and he is writing the addresses down. He then asked about a property at 8248 Long which is boarded up. The Building Commissioner said he is aware of that building and it is being worked on. Mayor Klein added that what happens all too often is when it is in a blighted state we file a deposition in court and unfortunately it can go on forever because the justices want to give the people more time and especially because of the economic conditions of the country at this time, they are even slower in making a ruling. The Mayor says that he also hates to see these properties.
- DEPT. OF ADMINISTRATION** The Mayor then invited the Reavis students to come up front after the City Council meeting is adjourned and that anyone at the front table or at the Council table could sign their government class papers.
