**CALL TO ORDER**  
**ROLL CALL**

The meeting of October 8, 2014 was called to order by Mayor Harry Klein at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber, 6530 W. 79<sup>th</sup> Street. Roll Call indicated the following Council members present: Mayor Klein (Chair), Alderman Foy, Looney, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski, and Alderman Pyle. Absent: Deputy Clerk Chisholm. Also present Treasurer Viverito, and Attorney Vince Cainkar.

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the Flag.

**JOURNAL**

Motion made by Alderman Grider, seconded by Looney, to approve the meeting of September 24, 2014 as presented was unanimously approved by the voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

**CURRENT BILL**

Motion made by Alderman Grider, seconded by Szymczak, to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated: 7 ayes, 0 nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting aye: Alderman Szymczak, Looney, Pacella, Foy, Grider, Pyle, and Piznarski.

**DEPT. OF ZONING 42-10-14**

Alderman Grider, seconded by Looney made a motion to approve Ordinance #42-10-14, AUTHORIZING A VARIATION TO ALLOW THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN OVERSIZED GARAGE AT 7807 SOUTH LARAMIE. A roll call vote indicated: 7 ayes, 0 nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting aye: Alderman Looney, Pacella, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski, Pyle, and Alderman Grider.

**DEPT. OF ZONING 43-10-14**

Alderman Grider, seconded by Foy made a motion to approve Ordinance #43-10-14, APPROVING THE SOBCZAK RESUBDIVISION OF THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 8200 SOUTH LAMON & 8202 SOUTH LAMON. A roll call vote indicated: 7 ayes, 0 nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting aye: Alderman Foy, Grider, Piznarski, Looney, Szymczak, Pyle, and Alderman Pacella.

**DEPT. OF PUBLIC SAFETY**
