- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of November 9, 2011 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79th Street, Burbank, IL.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following members present: Alderman Foy, Looney, Szymczak, Grider, Piznarski, Pacella and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Cainkar.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the minutes of October 26, 2011 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pyle, Piznarski, Foy, Grider, Looney, Szymczak and Pacella.

- DEPT. OF ADMINISTRATION** Mayor Klein told everyone that at 11:00 a.m. on Veterans Day there will be a ceremony at State Road and Melvina dedicated to our veterans who served this country. The band from Reavis high school will be there playing the "Star Spangled Banner" as well as hundreds of other people and he told the council and the audience that everyone is invited..
- NEW BUSINESS** Alderman Foy said he would like to have the Attorney draw up a license agreement for a resident on 8101 Lamon who has been using part of a street for access to his garage but wants to pave it and since it is City property he has to get permission from the City to do this. Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Pyle to authorize the attorney to draw up a license agreement for the property at 8101 Lamon. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Szymczak, Looney, Pacella, Foy, Pyle, Grider and Piznarski.
- CITIZEN'S REPORT** Mayor Klein recognized Mr. Dan Circelli of 5651 W. 83rd Place, who said he had a complaint about a house at 5650 W. 83rd Place who have garbage piled in the back of the garage since January.. He said he called the blight officer twice and the police department and nothing has been done about it and he knows pictures were taken of it. Mayor Klein said he would see that this matter was taken care of.
