- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of October 26, 2011 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79<sup>th</sup> Street, Burbank, IL
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following members present: Alderman Foy, Looney, Szymczak, Grider, Piznarski, Pacella and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the minutes of October 12, 2011 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Piznarski, Pacella, Looney, Pyle, Grider, Foy and Szymczak.
- DEPT. OF ZONING** Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Szymczak to untable **11-05-4 JD Moore & Assoc. LLC, 8250 S. Cicero requesting a rezoning from “C” to “R-3” and special use for residential care facility.** A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Looney, Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski and Grider.
- Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to authorize the attorney to prepare an ordinance for Item 11-09-1 **Jose Corral – 8100 S. Laramie requesting a variation to install a 6’ privacy fence on front yard side set back. Approved by Zoning.** A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Grider, Foy, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle, Pacella and Looney.
- Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Szymczak to authorize the attorney to prepare an ordinance for Item 11-05-4 **J.D. Moore and Association, LLC – requesting rezoning from “C” to “R-3” and Special Use for Residential Care facility, approximately 4000 sq. ft. of building to be used as a hospice residence. Approved by Zoning.** A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pyle, Piznarski, Foy, Grider, Looney, Szymczak and Pacella.
- DEPT. OF ADMINISTRATION** Mayor Klein then invited the Reavis students to come up front after the meeting is adjourned and that anyone at the front table or the Council table could sign their government class papers.
