



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
MARCH 14, 2012

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of March 14, 2012 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79th Street, Burbank, IL.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Foy, Looney, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the minutes of February 22, 2012 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Looney, Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski and Grider.
- PUBLIC HEARING** Mayor Klein then turned the meeting over to Attorney Vince Cainkar to conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. Attorney Cainkar said at this time we have the hearing for the annual proposed appropriation ordinance which is required by law before the ordinance is passed. The ordinance has been available for public inspection. He then asked the audience if there were any comments or suggestions regarding this ordinance. Mayor Klein said since there is none let the records reflect that this public hearing on the appropriation ordinance was held pursuant to law. Attorney Vince Cainkar said this ordinance will be on the agenda at the next Council meeting which is March 28, 2012.
- DEPT. OF PUBLIC WORKS** Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the **Department of Public Works Collective Bargaining Agreement January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2016**. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Piznarski, Pacella, Looney, Pyle, Grider, Foy and Szymczak.
- DEPT. OF ZONING** Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Szymczak to reappoint Tom Phillips as Commissioner, **Zoning, Planning and Development Commission**, for a three year term beginning April 28, 2012 and expiring April 28, 2015. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Foy, Szymczak, Grider, Looney, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle.
- DEPT. OF ADMINISTRATION** Mayor Klein asked the indulgence of the City Council in passing **Ordinance No. 5-3-12 amending Section 3-5 Limitation of Number of Licenses issued Chapter 3, Alcoholic Beverages of the Burbank Municipal Code, pertaining to liquor licenses**. Alderman Grider

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made the motion seconded by Alderman Pacella to approve Ordinance No. 5-3-12 as outlined above. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pacella, Grider, Piznarski, Looney, Pyle, Szymczak and Foy. Mayor Klein then informed everyone that the City of Burbank declared "Arbor Day" as April 27, 2012 and in honor of Arbor Day we will be planting 60 native trees throughout the City of Burbank (including parkways, 79th street and State Road.)

Mayor Klein then invited the Reavis students to come up after the meeting is adjourned and that anyone at the front table or at the Council table could sign their government class papers. He then wished everyone a Happy St. Patrick's day as well as a Happy St. Joseph's day.

There being no further business to be brought before the City Council, The Chair asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Alderman Szymczak seconded by Alderman Pyle to adjourn was agreed upon by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
