



REGULAR MEETING

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of March 28, 2012 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79th Street, Burbank, IL.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following council members present: Alderman Foy, Looney, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach, Treasurer Viverito and Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Looney to approve the minutes of March 14, 2012 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pyle, Piznarski, Foy, Grider, Looney, Szymczak and Pacella.
- CLERK'S REPORT** Clerk Roach reported that City Hall will be closed Friday, April 6 in commemoration of Good Friday. She also reported that City stickers will be on sale starting Monday, April 9, 2012.
- DEPT. OF FINANCE** Alderman Grider made the motion seconded by Alderman Pyle to approve **Ordinance No. 4-3-12 providing for an appropriation for the general fund for the fiscal year beginning January 2, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 for the City of Burbank.** A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Grider, Foy, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle, Pacella and Looney.
- DEPT. OF ZONING** Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Pyle to authorize the attorney to prepare an ordinance for #12-02-1 Olympic Signs for Burlington Coat Factory 8320 Cicero, Burbank, IL. 60459 requesting a variation to allow installation of an oversized sign. This was approved by Zoning. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Looney, Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski and Grider.
- CITIZEN'S REPORT** The Chair recognized Monica Leffers of 7952 Sayre Avenue who had some concerns after she had an attempted home invasion. She said that her attempted break in was not on the police blotter and she was also concerned that there is not enough police protection on their block. Mayor Klein assured her that he was keenly aware of the problems on that block and he had talked with the Police chief about an incident on that block. He told her that you might not see them, but the police are there. He also told her not to be reluctant to use 911 as long as there is a reason. She said she thought 3:00 a.m. would be a good time for the police to come around. and he told her there are police out then and also detectives and police in unmarked cars.
