

News Dec 2009

BU 17 December – Criminal Trespass to Residence, Disorderly Conduct, (Drunkenness)

BR Marek Scislowicz M/40yoa, LKA 7747 W. 81st Place, Bridgeview, IL was arrested for the aforementioned offenses. Police were called to the home of a Burbank resident who related that Scislowicz entered his unlocked front door, laid down on his couch and went to sleep. Upon the officers' arrival, they observed Scislowicz sleeping on the couch. While officers were speaking to Scislowicz they detected a strong odor of alcohol emitting from his person. Scislowicz stated to officers that he thought he was in his own residence. Scislowicz was transported to Christ Hospital by ambulance for further evaluation. Scislowicz has an 11 January 2010 court date at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

NE 09 December – Battery (Warrant)

SW Darnell M. Lofton M/25yoa, LKA 3787 W. 78th Street, Chicago, IL was arrested by Burbank Police Department Detectives on a battery warrant stemming from an incident which occurred on 17 November 2009 at the Jewel food store located at 79th and Cicero Avenue. On 17 November Lofton attempted to steal two bottles of vodka from the store. When Lofton was confronted by security personnel, Lofton struck the security officer in the face and fled the store dropping the bottles of vodka and a manila envelope that he had in his possession. When police arrived at the scene it was discovered that the envelope contained Lofton's resume which provided information as to Lofton's age, address and other personal information. After numerous attempts to contact Lofton were unsuccessful, Burbank Police Detectives obtained a warrant for Lofton's arrest. On 9 December 2009, Chicago Police Officers stopped Lofton in connection with an unrelated incident. When the officers ran Lofton's information in the computer system they discovered the outstanding warrant for Lofton's arrest. Lofton was turned over to the Burbank Police Department and was processed. Lofton's next court date is 9 February 2010 at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

08 December – Violation of City Ordinance (Failure to Provide Heat)

Maria Budz F/71yoa, LKA 6135 S. Mason, Chicago, IL was arrested under Burbank Ordinance for failure to provide minimal heat to an apartment building she owns in the 7800 block of Rutherford Avenue. An officer was called to the scene by tenants of the building complaining that there was no heat within the building. Upon the

officer's arrival he observed that the building was extremely cold and that he could see his breath as he was speaking to the tenants inside of their apartments. When the officer contacted Budz on the phone he explained the ordinance to her and at this point Budz used profanity towards the officer and advised the officer that she was not going to turn on the heat for the tenants since they don't pay their rent. Budz hung up on the officer at this time. A short time later Budz arrived at the building and was cited for the offense. Budz has a 23 December 2009 court date at the Bridgeview Courthouse. The city ordinance states the minimum temperature for a common heating plant to a residential building at this time of year be 65 degrees from 11p.m. to 6:30a.m., and 70 degrees from 6:30a.m. to 11p.m.

05 December – Disorderly Conduct



Talman L. Dean M/25yoa, LKA 7917 S. Green, Chicago, Ill was arrested for disorderly conduct at the Best Western Motel after police responded to reports of a naked male subject banging on motel doors. Upon arrival, the officers located Dean in a room naked and Dean advised the officers that he had in fact been knocking on doors. Dean who appeared intoxicated was arrested and charged with disorderly conduct. Dean has a 23 December 2009 court date at the Bridgeview court house.

Nov 2009

18 November – Criminal Damage to Property



John R. Allen M/21yoa, LKA 14860 S. Menard, Oak Forest, Ill



Joseph J. Manning M/20yoa, LKA 7711 S. Melvina, Burbank, Ill

The above mentioned subjects were arrested for criminal damage to property after both subjects confessed to slashing two tires on the victim's vehicle. Prior to the incident, Allen sent the victim a text message using Manning's phone, advising the victim that he wanted to fight the victim and that the victim should come out of his residence. The victim advised Allen that he had no desire to meet with Allen. Allen and Manning admitted to detectives that they slashed the tires on the victim's vehicle after he refused to meet with them. Both subjects stated that they were intoxicated at the time of the crime. Allen and Manning were charged with criminal damage to property and were given an 11 January 2010 court date at the Bridgeview court house.

20 November 2009 – Murder



Marvin E. Jones M/54, LKA 3142 W. 85th Street, Chicago, Ill was charged with the murder of a Burbank resident which occurred on 02 November 2008. On 04 November 2008 Burbank police were called to an apartment complex located in the 5500 block of 87th Street by the victim's landlord when he discovered the body. The victim was found inside his apartment with an apparent gunshot wound to his head. At the time of the murder, Burbank police detectives interviewed numerous subjects, including Jones. During the police interview in 2008, Jones stated to detectives that he was with the victim in the victim's apartment earlier on 02 November, but when he left the apartment the victim was alive. Jones named two subjects who would verify his story that the victim was alive when Jones left the apartment. Over the past year, detectives gathered evidence and conducted interviews pertaining to this case. On 19 November 2009, police detectives picked up Jones and the two subjects who verified Jones' story last year and brought each of them to the Burbank Police Station and re-interviewed them. Presented with the evidence that the detectives had gathered during the last year, the two subjects recanted their stories and advised detectives

that Jones had asked each of them to lie to the police. Specifically the subjects stated that Jones told them if they were asked, to tell the police he was with both of them at the time of the murder. When confronted with the fact that he no longer had an alibi, along with the new evidence that was discovered, Jones provided a video confession to his involvement in the murder, and admitted that he shot the victim. Jones has a prior conviction for Murder and served 20 years in the custody of the Illinois Department of Corrections. On 21 November 2009, Jones was taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview court house and bond was set by Judge Kunkel in the amount of 1 million dollars.

12 November 2009 – Retail Theft (Felony)



Offender Name: ANTHONY, ANTONIO R Anthony R. Arrington Jr. M/35, LKA 902 Coventry Avenue, Toledo, Ohio



Offender Name: CRANE, CHARLES O Charles O. Crane M/51, LKA 8534 S. Burley Avenue, Chicago, IL

The above-mentioned subjects were arrested for retail theft after they were observed by Burbank Police Department Camera Operator acting suspiciously behind the building located in the 7700 block of Cicero Ave. Officers arriving on the scene were advised by the operator that one of the suspects had dropped something from his pocket. The item was recovered by the officers which in turn provided evidence that Arrington and Crane had stolen a Fender guitar from the Sam Ash Music Store in Burbank. Arrington and Crane were charged with felony retail theft and were brought to a bond hearing on 13 November at the Bridgeview court house.

07 November 2009 – Unlawful Use of a Weapon



Offender Name: JOHNSON, MATTHEW M Matthew Johnson M/25, LKA 1944 W. 163rd Street, Markham, IL was arrested for U.U.W. after he shot a subject in the parking lot located in the 7700 block of Cicero Ave. The victim and Johnson were involved in a verbal altercation in the lot when Johnson fired several shots at the victim striking him once in the chest.

The victim fled the scene with a friend and was later taken to the hospital for treatment of his gunshot wound. The offender fled the scene and was apprehended a short time later by Alsip Police after he led them on a chase which ended in the area of 151st Street and Will Cook Rd. The victim advised police that he did not wish to pursue charges against Johnson and that he "would take care of it on the streets". Johnson was charged with U.U.W. and was given a 2 December court date at the Bridgeview court house.

05 November 2009 – Possession of Cannabis



Offender Name: DZIADKOWIEC, JACEK P Jacek P. Dziadkowiec M/22, LKA 9649 W. 88th Place, Palos Hills, IL was arrested for possession of cannabis after the vehicle in which he was a passenger was stopped for a minor traffic violation. Upon approaching the vehicle, the officer detected the smell of the burnt odor of cannabis emanating from the vehicle.

During questioning of the driver and Dziadkowiec, Dziadkowiec admitted to the officer that he had a small amount of cannabis on his person. Dziadkowiec was placed under arrest for possession of cannabis and was given a 4 December court date at the Bridgeview court house.

05 November 2009 – Domestic Battery



Offender Name: ZINK, MATTHEW M Matthew A. Zink M/32, LKA 8032 S. Mobile Avenue, Burbank, IL was arrested for Domestic Battery after police were called to a disturbance in the 8000 block of Mulligan. Upon arrival, the officer responding to the call observed the victim laying on the street with Zink standing over him and the officer further observed Zink

kick the victim in the head. Zink was placed under arrest and charged with Domestic Battery based on the fact that Zink and the victim reside in the same household. Zink has a 6 November court date at the Bridgeview court house.

Oct 2009

31 October 2009 – Warrant Arrest



Offender Name: LOVE, ANDREA A
 Andrea A. Love F/24, LKA 11926 S. Calumet, Chicago, IL was arrested pursuant to an arrest warrant outstanding in McHenry County. The arresting officer made a traffic stop on Love's vehicle in the 5700 block of W. 79th Street. Upon running her information in his computer, he was advised of the outstanding arrest warrant. The warrant was based on charges for unlawful delivery of a controlled substance and unlawful possession of a controlled substance. The bond amount was \$30,000.00. Love posted the required bond and was released.

21 October 2009 – D.U.I.



Offender Name: MYTNIK, ROMAN B
 Roman Mytnik M/31, LKA 7942 S. Rutherford Avenue, Burbank was arrested for D.U.I. after officers responded to an accident at Luther Burbank Elementary School. When officers arrived at the scene they observed a vehicle crashed into the wall of the school building. Mytnik advised officers that he drove off of the roadway to relieve himself and that is when he struck the building. Mytnik was charged with D.U.I. along with other Illinois Vehicle Code violations and has an 11 December court date at the Bridgeview court house.

25 October 2009 – D.U.I.



Offender Name: DELUNA, ANDRES B
 Andres Deluna M/28, LKA 6150 S. Archer Road, Summit, Ill was arrested for D.U.I. after officers responded to an accident in the 6000 block of 78th Street. When officers arrived at the scene they observed that a vehicle had crashed into a utility pole and the driver had fled the scene. A witness to the accident provided a description of the driver and Deluna was apprehended by officers a short time later in the 7700 block of Melvina. Deluna was charged with D.U.I. along with other Illinois Vehicle Code violations and has a 4 December court date at the Bridgeview court house.

22 October 2009 – Public Intoxication

 Carl W. Deutecher M/51, LKA 8508 S. Parkside, Burbank was arrested for public intoxication after he was found laying on the ground in the 8500 block of Parkside Avenue. The officer who arrived at the scene observed Deutecher on the ground and in a highly intoxicated state. Officers attempted to speak with Deutecher but were unable, due to his state of intoxication. An officer called for a paramedic unit and Mr. Deutecher was transported to Christ Hospital for treatment. Mr. Deutecher has a 24 November court date at the Bridgeview court house.

21 October 2009 – Criminal Trespass to Vehicle

 Alejandro Morin M/29, LKA 1623 S Oak Park, Berwyn, IL
 Candelario Morin M/29, LKA 5016 W 29th Place, Cicero, IL



The aforementioned subjects were arrested for criminal trespass to vehicle after they were observed via camera system by a Burbank Police Department Camera Operator entering vehicles in the shopping plaza in the 7700 block of Cicero Avenue. The operator who was monitoring the camera system was able to provide the location of, and a thorough description of, the offenders to responding units via radio communication. In addition, the operator was able to provide the responding

officers with the movements of the offenders up to the point when the responding officers arrived on the scene and made the arrest. The offenders have an 11 December court date at the Bridgeview court house.

19 October 2009 – Battery

Ignatius P. Dooley M/52, LKA 5132 W 82nd Place, Burbank, IL was arrest for a battery that occurred at the Dalton Pub. Dooley approached the victim inside the establishment and proceeded to ask the victim questions of a personal nature. The victim who was taken aback by Dooley's advances requested that he leave her alone and at this point proceeded to another area of the bar to avoid Dooley. Dooley followed the victim and upon approaching her a second time, Dooley poured a beverage over the victims head and fled the scene. The victim advised the responding units that she did not know who the offender was at the time of the incident. Burbank Police Department Detectives were able to gather information on the suspect and upon showing the victim a photo of Dooley, he was positively identified. Dooley was arrested on 21 October and was given a 02 December court date at the Bridgeview court house.

05 October 2009 – Unlawful Use of a Weapon, Defacing Identification Marks of a Firearm, No FOID Card



Daniel Villanueva M/20, LKA 5631 W. 23rd Place, Cicero, IL was arrested for the above- mentioned charges after he was observed in the 7900 block of Cicero Avenue with a loaded handgun by a Burbank Police Department Camera Operator. The operator who was monitoring the camera system observed Villanueva repeatedly removing and replacing the clip out of and into a semi-automatic weapon. The operator further observed Villanueva leave the scene in a vehicle and was able to provide the vehicle information to the radio room, which in turn broadcasted a Flash message to the NET TEN units on the street. A short time later, Bedford Park units observed the vehicle in question in the 6600 block of Cicero Avenue and a felony stop was conducted on the vehicle. Burbank units arrived on the scene, the weapon was located and Villanueva was taken into custody. Villanueva has a 26 October court date at the Bridgeview court house. (Net Ten is the radio channel that the Burbank Police Department shares with eight surrounding departments, including the Bedford Park Police Department.)

03 October 2009 – Criminal Damage to Property

On the above-mentioned date, four juvenile offenders damaged property located in Harr Park, 8300 block of LeClaire Avenue. The juvenile offenders damaged the wet concrete that had been poured earlier in the day and using a sledge hammer damaged a steel picnic table. Burbank Police Detectives utilizing the camera system that is in place in the park were able to view the footage, freeze on an image of the offenders and create photos of the offenders. Once those photos were captured they were shown to the Burbank Police Department School Resource Officer who was able to provide information to the identity of the offenders. On 07 October, all four juvenile offenders were taken into custody and charged with criminal damage to property. All four juveniles admitted to the crime.

Sept 2009

07 September – Disorderly Conduct

Jozef Ciesla M/64yoa, LKA 4527 S. Francisco, Chicago, IL was arrested for disorderly



conduct in the 6600 block of 85th Street. Patrol officers in the area were flagged down by the victim who reported to the officers that a green in color Chevrolet Malibu had been following her as she walked down 85th Street. The victim reported to the officers that the vehicle in question had driven slowly next to her or just behind her. The victim further stated that if she stopped walking the vehicle would stop and once she proceeded to walk the vehicle would continue to follow

her. While speaking with officers the victim was able to point to the vehicle and officers conducted an investigative stop on the suspicious vehicle. Once officers approached the vehicle they encountered the driver of the vehicle, Ciesla. Officers observed at this time that Ciesla was sweating profusely and appeared nervous. Officers further observed an empty package for a sexual device inside the vehicle and a package of lubricant. Ciesla was asked to get out of the vehicle and upon conducting a pat down search of his person, officers discovered Ciesla had the sexual device in use on his person. The victim wished to sign a complaint against Ciesla, and Ciesla was charged with disorderly conduct. Ciesla has a 24 September court date at the Bridgeview court house.

08 September – Robbery

Ayman M. Abdelaziz M/21yoa, LKA 7833 S. Kilbourn Chicago, IL was arrested for robbery of a business located in the 6700 block of 79th street. Abdelaziz approached the clerk inside the business, demanded money while implying that he had a weapon. After the clerk gave Abdelaziz the money, Abdelaziz left the business and entered his vehicle. At this point in time an officer arrived at the scene and upon seeing the officer, Abdelaziz fled the area ramming the officer's squad car. The officer was able to obtain the license plate on Abdelaziz' vehicle as well as capture his image on the in-car camera system located in his squad car. On 8 September detectives located Abdelaziz and charged him with one count of robbery. Abdelaziz is currently being held in the Cook County jail on a \$150,000.00 bond.

Aug 2009

28 August – Burglary

Allen E. Kronenberger M/35yoa, LKA 6135 W. Birmingham Ave, Chicago Ridge, IL was arrested for burglary to a business located in the 6000 block of 79th street. The burglary took place on October 22, 2008. Following the burglary, Burbank evidence technicians recovered a blood sample at the scene. The sample was sent to the Illinois State Police Crime Lab for analysis which subsequently came back matching the DNA profile of Kronenberger. Detectives located Kronenberger and charged him with one count of Burglary. Kronenberger is currently being held at the Cook County jail on a \$100,000.00 bond.

23 August 2009 – Driving Under Influence of Alcohol, Battery, Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer, Aggravated Assault and Illinois Vehicle Code Violations



Robert Toporkiewicz M/34yoa, LKA 6317 W. 64th Pl, Chicago, IL was arrested for the above-mentioned offenses after he was involved in a motor vehicle accident E/B on 79th Street at Cicero Ave. Following the accident, Toporkiewicz approached the passenger in the vehicle he had just struck and aggressively threatened the passenger in a manner which caused the passenger to believe Toporkiewicz was going to strike him. When officers arrived they suspected that Toporkiewicz was under the influence of alcohol. Subsequent to being placed under arrest Toporkiewicz resisted officers' attempt to handcuff him and battered the arresting officer. Toporkiewicz has a 9 September court date at the Bridgeview court house.

23 August – Public Intoxication



Janusz Dziaba M/20yoa, LKA 7740 S. Massasoit, Burbank was arrested for public intoxication after he was observed in the area of the St. Albert carnival yelling profanities at carnival patrons. When approached by officers they smelled a strong odor of alcohol coming from Dziaba. Dziaba has a 6 October court date at the Bridgeview court house.

25 August – Public Indecency and Disorderly Conduct



Artisia D. Young M/38yoa, LKA 1050 w. 84th Street Chicago, IL was arrested for public indecency and disorderly conduct after he exposed his sex organs to two females in the 5800 block of 79th Street. The victims, who

were inside their apartment when Young yelled at them requesting to use the phone, when Young's request was refused he then asked to use the bathroom. Once again Young was refused and it was at this point in time he exposed himself to the victims. The victims called police and Young was apprehended a short time later. Young has a 15 September court date at the Bridgeview court house.

10 August 2009 Prostitution



Sabrina Streeter F/26 LKA 7955 S Ellis Chicago, Il was arrested for prostitution. Burbank Police working on information that certain female subjects were soliciting for sex on Cicero Avenue, conducted surveillance in the area and observed Streeter walking up and down the street waving at vehicles. A Burbank Police

Undercover Officer was waved down by Streeter and after a brief conversation Streeter offered to perform oral sex on the officer for fifty dollars. Streeter was subsequently arrested and has a 15 September court date at the Bridgeview court house.

July 2009

20 July 2009- Hit and Run Accident

The Burbank Police Department is looking for the driver involved in a roll over, hit and run accident which occurred at the intersection of 85th Street and Melvina Ave at approximately 2:50 P.M on 20 July 2009. The offending vehicle is described by witnesses as being a maroon in color Ford F-150 with temporary tags and heavy front end damage. The only information on the driver at this time is that the driver was a male. The offending vehicle was last seen driving south bound Austin Ave from 87th Street. 19 July 2009-Public Intoxication

Marcin Wojtowicz, M/18yoa, 7811 S. Mason, Burbank was arrested and charged with public intoxication after he was observed walking in the 7900 block of McVicker Ave swaying from side to side and nearly falling in to the traffic lanes of 79th Street. Upon stopping Wojtowicz, the officer smelled a strong odor of alcohol coming from the subject and observed that the subject slurred his speech. Wojtowicz has an 11 August 2009 court date at the Bridgeview court house.



17 July 2009-Possession of Cannabis, Driving with a Revoked License, Failure to Wear a Seatbelt

Michael G. O'Malley M/24yoa, 5329 Woodland Dr, Oak Forest, IL was arrested and charged with possession of cannabis and traffic violations following a traffic stop in the 7800 block of Major Ave for failure to wear a seatbelt. Upon stopping O'Malley and running his driver's license information through the computer it was ascertained that O'Malley's driver's license was revoked. Subsequent to placing O'Malley under arrest and towing his vehicle, an inventory search of the vehicle was conducted and a baggie containing suspected cannabis was discovered. Once at the Burbank Police Department, a custodial search of O'Malley was conducted at which time the arresting officer discovered five small baggies containing suspected cannabis in O'Malley's shoe. The total weight of all cannabis discovered was approximately thirteen grams. O'Malley has an 11 August 2009 court date at the Bridgeview court house.



13 July 2009- Possession of Cannabis Over 30 Grams, Illinois Vehicle Code Violation

Kevin Morgan, M/20yoa, 7644 S. Octavia, Bridgeview, IL was arrested and charged with possession of cannabis following a traffic stop in the 8300 block of Sayre Ave. During the course of the investigation and a subsequent search of Morgan's vehicle, officers discovered approximately one hundred sixty grams of cannabis, electronic scales and over \$20,000.00 in United States currency. Morgan has an 11 August 2009 court date at the Bridgeview court house. The Burbank Police Department has initiated seizure proceedings for the currency as well as Morgan's 2004 Cadillac.



12 July 2009 Home Invasion



Elias Martinez M/48 LKA 3715 Hemlock, East Chicago, Indiana and Corey Frith M/23 LKA 3428 Grand Blvd., East Chicago, Indiana were arrested for Home Invasion after breaking into a residence located in the 8200 block of Natoma while armed with a hand gun. Once inside the residence the offenders ordered the victims to turn over certain properties and punched the victims about their bodies. When the offenders left the residence the victims summoned the police and provided a description of the offenders and their vehicle. Responding officers observed the offenders' vehicle and following a brief pursuit of the offenders' vehicle, the offenders exited their vehicle and fled on foot. With the assistance of the Burbank Police Department K-9 unit, offender Frith was located hiding in a backyard in the 8000 block of Major; offender Elias was able to elude police but was later arrested in Indiana with the assistance of the Illiana Task Force. Elias waved extradition and is now in custody at the Cook County Jail along with Frith awaiting their next court date. Information provided by the offenders indicates that this was not a random act.



09 July 09 – Criminal Defacement, Aggravated Assault, Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor.

Marchello R. Cappelletti. M/22yoa, 7810 S Nagle, Burbank and a 16 year old Burbank juvenile were arrested and charged with five counts of criminal defacement after both were observed by a witness spray painting graffiti on garages in the 7800 block of Nagle. Cappelletti was also charged with contributing to the delinquency of a minor and aggravated assault for threatening the witness. Cappelletti has a 7 August 2009 court date at the Bridgeview court house. The juvenile will be petitioned to the juvenile court system.



03 July 09 – Possession of Cannabis

Marcin Wojtowicz M/18yoa, 7811 S. Mason, Burbank was arrested and charged with possession of cannabis following a traffic stop in the area of 85th street and Meade Ave. During the course of the investigation and subsequent search of Wojtowicz's vehicle and residence, officers discovered approximately one hundred fifty grams of cannabis, electronic scales, packaging materials and \$1,100.00 in United States currency. Wojtowicz's next court date will be July 24th at the Bridgeview court house. The Burbank Police Department has initiated seizure proceedings for the currency as well as Wojtowicz's 2005 Chrysler Pacifica.

June 2009

15 June 09- Barricaded Subject

At 10:29 PM on 14 June 09 Burbank Police responded to a call of an armed subject threatening to kill himself at a residence in the 8000 block of Mansfield. Responding officers arrived on the scene and determined that the subject was armed with a handgun and also verified that a second subject, later identified as a cousin, inside the residence. Burbank officers immediately set up a perimeter on the residence and began evacuating neighboring residents.

An ILEAS level one call out was activated for man power support and the South Suburban Emergency Response Team (SSERT) was also notified. Negotiations with the armed subject and the other family member was initiated and this communication lasted until 7:11 AM on 15 June 09. At this time a shot was heard from inside the residence and the cousin exited the front door of the residence. SSERT made a dynamic entry into the residence and the armed subject was located in an upstairs bathroom with a single gun shot wound to his head. The subject was exhibiting signs of life and paramedics immediately began life support aid and he was transported to Christ Hospital.

At this time it appears that the relative of the armed subject remained in the residence of his own accord in an attempt to keep the armed subject calm and in an attempt to prevent the subject from harming himself.

As a precautionary measure Liberty Junior High School was closed for the day and the gymnasium was used for residents displaced during the incident.

Burbank Surveillance Camera Success

On December 2, 2008, just weeks after the Burbank Police Surveillance network went live, operators working the cameras observed a theft from a motor vehicle taking place in the parking lot of the Kohl's Store, 7608 S. La Crosse. The Offenders were monitored until responding units arrived on the scene. Officers were directed to the offending vehicle at which time a short pursuit ensued. Officers terminated the pursuit but gathered enough information to allow detectives to get the offenders identified.

The male offender was identified as Linza F. Davis, 53 yoa, 6743 S. Winchester, Chicago, IL. A warrant was issued for his arrest and Davis was subsequently picked up by Chicago Police. On April 17th, 2009 with the video evidence stacked against him Davis plead guilty to theft and fleeing and attempting to elude an officer and was sentenced to 36 days jail and a fine.



This is just one of over 40 cases that the new Burbank Police Surveillance network has been involved in. The system has been expanded to 21 cameras covering several areas in Burbank. (Enclosed picture shows Davis and his accomplice just after completing the theft from a vehicle.)

On April 14, 2009 at 12:09 PM the offender described as; male black, thin build, 35-40 yoa, wearing dark clothing a dark hat, glasses, and a mustache, entered Charter One Bank, 7900 S. Laverne, Burbank, IL and demanded money. The

Offender indicated that he had a weapon but did not produce one. The offender was able to leave the bank with over \$3600 USC. He was last scene running north across 79th Street and East through an alley. As the offender was running from the bank the dye pack activated and he dropped the money. On April 13th, 2009 Stanley Frances M/ 49 yoa, 14115 S. Western Ave, Apt. 411, Blue Island was arrested for a residential burglary case which occurred in Burbank on July 29th, 2008 in the 8300 block of Lockwood. Investigators say that Frances



may be implicated in several more residential burglaries throughout the southwest suburbs.

In July of 2008 Frances allegedly gained entry into the residence through a sliding door located in the rear of the residence. During the burglary the homeowner came home and discovered the offender in her residence and witnessed him flee the house.

Burbank Police Evidence Technician B. Casey processed the scene and in doing so discovered what appeared to be human sweat left by the offender on a window in the residence. The evidence was collected and sent to the Illinois State Police Crime Lab for DNA analysis.

On Sept. 24th, 2008 police received a DNA profile match from the Illinois State Police. The collected sample was entered into the Combined DNA Index System (C.O.D.I.S.) and a positive match of Frances was revealed. C.O.D.I.S. is a database system used by local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies in linking serial crimes together and also identifying offenders with DNA evidence. This gave investigators enough information to obtain an arrest warrant for Frances.

On April 13th, 2009 Crestwood Police located Francis and a name check revealed the active warrant for his arrest. It was also learned at that time that Francis was in possession of items that may have been taken in a burglary which had just occurred in Crestwood. Frances taken to a bond hearing and Judge Peter Felice set the bond at \$300,000/ 10% and Frances is currently being held at the Cook County Jail.
