#### Update: To Officer Involved Shooting

On November 8th, 2010 charges were filed on the driver of the offending vehicle. Gene R. Poirier, M/19 yoa, 2704 W. Evergreen Ave., Chicago, IL. Poirier has been charged with Reckless Driving (Class A Misdemeanor), improper lane usage, and a city ordinance for Unlawful Use of Weapon. He was released on bond and has a pending court date of January 5th, 2011 at 1:30 PM at the Bridgeview Court building. Charges are still pending on the second offender who remains in critical condition at Christ Hospital.

#### 07 Nov 10 - Officer Involved Shooting

On Sunday, November 7, 2010 at approximately 0143 hours a Burbank Police Department officer observed a large disturbance in the parking lot of Americas Best Inn, 5001 W. 79th Street, Burbank. Upon further investigation the officer observed an 18 year old male pointing a handgun at a woman that was lying on the ground in the parking lot. The Burbank officer exited his vehicle, announced his office and ordered the offender to put down his weapon. The offender then pointed the handgun at the officer. The officer fearing for the safety of the down woman and the immediate deadly threat to his own safety fired his handgun striking the offender. The offender then entered the back seat of a friend's vehicle that then fled westbound on 79th street and was subsequently stopped by assisting officers at 6530 W. 79th Street (Burbank Fire Department). Two individuals along with the offender were taken into custody without incident and the weapon (handgun) was recovered from inside the vehicle. The offender was transported to Christ Hospital in Oak Lawn where he remains in critical condition after surgery.

As of this date and time the offenders Identity is being withheld pending notification of family members. The Illinois State Police Public Integrity Unit and the Cook County States Attorney Investigators have been called in and are investigating the incident.

Arriaga was arrested the next day at his residence. Arriaga was taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview Courthouse and his bond was set at \$300,000.00.

On the above date a Burbank resident contacted police after observing an unknown subject driving a black in color vehicle pull up to her mailbox and remove the out going mail that was inside. The vehicle was last seen northbound from the 8600 block of Laramie.

## 07 September 2010 Fire

On the above date police and fire personnel responded to a fire at the Rocking Robin Daycare. Upon speaking to the daycare owner she advised while working in the center she observed a small fire by the stove located in the kitchen. The owner attempted to put the fire out but was unable to do so. At this point she closed the kitchen door and escorted all of the children and workers from the building and then called 911. ## 21 July 2010 – Disorderly Conduct (Peeping Tom)

Vanderploeg M/23 yoa, LKA 7620 S Lockwood, Burbank, IL was arrested for the aforementioned offense after officers responded to a report that a subject was looking into a residence window at the 7600 block of Lorel Avenue. When officers arrived at the scene they observed Vanderploeg walking between houses in the area. When Vanderploeg made eye contact with the officers he attempted to flee the area but was apprehended by the officers. Vanderploeg was brought back to the scene and was positively identified as the person who was looking into the bathroom window of the female victim's residence. Vanderploeg was transported to the Burbank Police Department, processed and released after posting bond. Vanderploeg has a 09 September 2010 court date at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

## 08 July 2010 – Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse; Indecent Solicitation of a Child



John T. Collins M/44yoa, LKA 3505 Artesia Blvd., Torrance, CA was arrested for and charged with aggravated criminal sexual abuse and indecent solicitation of a child, following the completion of a seven-month investigation by Burbank Police Department Detectives. In December 2009 Detectives were notified that Collins had solicited and engaged in sexual intercourse with a sixteen year old female while he was visiting from out of state. The victim's mother notified the Burbank Police Department that Collins initially met the victim through the Craig's List website. During the course of the investigation Burbank Police Detectives were able to establish contact with Collins via e-mails in which a Detective posed as the victim. Unaware that he had been exchanging e-mails for the past seven months with a Burbank Police Department Detective, the Detective (who was posing as the victim) and Collins arranged a meeting. When Collins arrived at the arranged location he was taken into custody, arrested and charge.

## June 2010

## 01 June 2010 Burglary

Darnell C. Thiergood M/36/lka 4659 S. Drexel Chicago, Ill

Burbank officers were assigned to an alarm call at the Office Max, 7760 S. Cicero. Upon the officers arrival they observed Thiergood, exiting the store carrying merchandise that he had just stolen from within. Upon seeing the officers Thiergood attempted to flee the area but after a short foot pursuit and with the assistance of the Burbank K9 unit Thiergood was apprehended in the 7700 Block of Keating Avenue in Chicago. Thiergood was charged with Burglary and will appear in court at the Bridgeview courthouse.

## May 2010

## 17 May 2010 – Graffiti

Two Burbank juveniles were arrested for vandalizing ten homes in the 8200 block of Mason/Austin Avenue. The juveniles spray painted graffiti on the homes. The case was assigned to one of the Burbank Police Department's School Resource Officers and the officer recalled having seen this form of graffiti before. The officer confronted the juveniles who subsequently confessed to the crime. The juveniles will appear in court on 10 June 2010 at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

## 17 May 2010 – Aggravated Criminal Sexual Assault

Edgar Martinez M/21yoa, LKA 8104 S. Leamington, Burbank, IL was arrested for aggravated criminal sexual assault in the 8200 block of Laramie Avenue. While on routine patrol a Burbank Police Officer came upon a vehicle parked contrary to the flow of traffic in the 8200 block of Laramie Avenue. When the officer approached the vehicle, Martinez exited the rear passenger side of the vehicle with his pants down. While speaking with Martinez, the officer observed a female in the rear of the vehicle. In later questioning it was determined that Martinez and the female had engaged in sexual intercourse in the car. Also, upon further investigation it was revealed that Martinez was 21 years old and the female was a 14 year old juvenile. Martinez was charged with aggravated criminal sexual assault and was taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

## 12 May 2010 – Arm Robbery

Corie Martin M/31 yoa, LKA 11424 S. Racine, Chicago, IL was arrested in connection with several arm robberies which occurred in Burbank, Oak Lawn and Summit, IL after his fingerprints were recovered from the scene of an arm robbery and he was positively identified by the victims of each arm robbery incident.

On 12 May 2010, Martin entered the Grasshopper health food store located at 5624

W. 79th Street. Once inside the store, Martin produced a large club and demanded money from the loan clerk working at the time. After receiving cash from the victim, Martin fled the scene. A Burbank Police Department Evidence Technician was called to the scene and processed the store. Fingerprints were recovered and were sent to the Illinois State Police crime lab for processing. Burbank Police Detectives were notified by the State Police that the fingerprints recovered belonged to Martin. A photograph of Martin was obtained and the victim was able to identify him as the subject who committed the robbery. Detectives located Martin who subsequently was positively identified in a line up. Martin was also identified by two other victims for similar crimes that had occurred in Oak Lawn, IL and Summit, IL. Mr. Martin was charged with arm robbery and was taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

07 May 2010 - Theft of vehicle

Representatives from Value City Furniture, 8310 S. Cicero reported that between May 6th and May 7th persons or person unknown stole a 2000 Inte, box truck. The vehicle contained various furniture items with an estimated value of \$14,000.00. There are no suspects at this time.

April 2010

09 April 2010 – Robbery; Suspended License

Police were called to assist a robbery victim in the 6500 block of 79th street. When the officers arrived the victim gave a statement that she had been approached by a male who demanded that she give him her purse. When the victim refused, the male offender pushed the victim to the ground and forcibly removed her purse from her. The male offender fled the scene in a west bound direction on 79th street as a passenger in a vehicle driven by a female. The victim gave officers a description of the male and female offenders and the vehicle, which officers transmitted over the radio. A short time later Visockis and Rotto were stopped in the vehicle by Justice Police in the 8200 block of 79th street. The Illinois State's Attorney's Office approved felony charges against Visockis for robbery and he was processed and taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview Courthouse. Rotto was charged with driving while her license is suspended and was released after posting the required bond.

---

04 April 2010 – Attempt Burglary; Possession of Burglary Tools

Billy F. Jones M/35 yoa, LKA 6732 S. Wabash, Chicago, IL was arrested when police were called to a burglar alarm at a business located in the 8500 block of Cicero. When police arrived on the scene they observed Jones fleeing from the business. Officers apprehended Jones and after conducting a field interview were able to ascertain that Jones was in fact the person who attempted to commit the burglary. Officers confiscated a pry bar as well as a set of gloves that were used in the commission of the crime. The State's Attorney's Office approved felony charges for attempt burglary as well as possession of burglary tools. Jones was processed and was taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

1 April 2010 – Possession of Cannabis; Warrant Arrest

Juan Aranda M/39 yoa, LKA 7743 S. Neenah Burbank, IL was arrested for possession of cannabis when police recovered over four pounds of suspected cannabis from his residence. Also recovered were scales, grinders and other drug paraphernalia. During the investigation, officers ascertained that Aranda had two outstanding warrants for his arrest, one for driving under the influence and one for failure to appear. Aranda was processed and taken to a bond hearing at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

March 2010

25 March 2010 – Public Intoxication

Marek S. Scislowicz M/40 yoa, LKA 7747 W. 81st Place, Bridgeview, IL was arrested for public intoxication after police were called to the 8200 block of Rutherford in reference to a suspicious person call. When officers arrived on the scene they spoke to the complainant who related that Scislowicz had been looking into her yard and when the complainant's dog began to bark at Scislowicz, Scislowicz punched the dog. When officers approached Scislowicz they smelled a strong odor of alcohol emanating from his body. Although the complainant did not wish to sign a complaint against Scislowicz, Scislowicz was charged with violating the city ordinance for public intoxication and was given a 6 April 2010 court date at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

18 March 2010 – Burbank Ordinance – Unlawful Use of Weapon

Jose Duarte M/19 yoa, LKA 5136 W. 79th Street, Burbank was arrested for the above crime in the 7800 block of Leamington. Duarte was first

observed in Owens Park with a BB gun. A citizen, who called 911, related that she had observed a subject in the park displaying a weapon and provided a description of the subject to the 911 operator. Responding officers located a suspect matching that description (Duarte) in the 7800 block of Leamington. Officers discovered the weapon in the rear waist band of Duarte's pants. Duarte was arrested and charged on the local ordinance violation and was given a 04 May 2010 court date at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

02 March 2010 – Criminal Damage to Property; Hit and Run Accident

James D. Dangelo M/23 yoa, LKA 5026 W. 85th Street Burbank, IL was arrested after being involved in an altercation in the 7900 block of Harlem Avenue. The victim related to officers that while he was walking through the parking lot Dangelo drove his vehicle into the lot and attempted to run the victim over. The victim was able to avoid the attempt and it was at this point in time Dangelo exited his vehicle with a baseball bat in his hand, walked towards the victim's vehicle and proceeded to strike the vehicle with the bat. Dangelo broke out the passenger side window and shattered the windshield of the victim's vehicle. Dangelo then re-entered his vehicle and drove out of the lot onto Harlem Avenue. While exiting the lot Dangelo struck a vehicle. Shortly thereafter, Dangelo was stopped by Bridgeview Police, and was turned over to the Burbank Police Department. Dangelo was processed and given a court date of 6 April 2010 at the Bridgeview Courthouse.

20 February 2010 – Criminal Damage to Property; Public Intoxication

Edgardo Cuadrado M/19 yoa, LKA 7717 S.
