



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 10, 2010

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of February 10, 2010 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers, 6530 W. 79th Street, Burbank, IL.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Foy, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Clerk Roach and Attorney Gary Perlman. Absent: Alderman Pollard and Treasurer Viverito.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Pacella to approve the minutes of January 27, 2010 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Szymczak, Pacella, Foy, Pyle, Grider and Piznarski.
- CLERK'S REPORT** Clerk Roach reported that City Hall will be closed Monday, February 15, 2010 in commemoration of Presidents' day.
- PUBLIC HEARING 2010 ON THE CDBGP GRANT** Mayor Klein then turned the meeting over to Attorney Gary Perlman to conduct a public hearing on the 2010 Community Development Block Grant Program. Attorney Perlman called the public hearing to order at 7:32 p.m. and told the public that this is the second hearing and as we have done in previous years we have prepared an application for a grant request in the amount of \$85,000 for street reconstruction projects for 2010, the first one being Lorel Avenue between 76th Place on the north to 77th street on the south and the second street is 76th Place with Long avenue on the west and Lorel Avenue on the east. The total project cost would be \$177,077.00 approximately twice the amount of the grant. The project area is Census Tract 8209.01 block group 1, which contains 57.4% low/moderate income persons.
- Attorney Gary Perlman asked if there were any questions or alternate suggestions with respect to the application from the City Council or the audience. The Chair recognized Mr. Irving Gaskin of 5046 W. 77th St. Burbank, Illinois who wanted to know who do you hire to do the work? Attorney Perlman said at this point we are just talking about the project itself and it has not gone out for bid. Mayor Klein said we go out for bid and we accept the lowest **qualified bidder**. Mayor Klein told Mr. Gaskin that was a good question. He then said since there were no more questions let the record reflect that the meeting was held pursuant to law
- PUBLIC WORKS** Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve **Resolution No. 2-1-10 approving a grant application for the 2010 Cook County Development Block Grant Program**. A roll

call vote indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Pacella, Pyle, Szymczak, Foy, Piznarski and Grider.

Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Pyle to approve **Ordinance No. 6-2-10 dissolving certain special service Areas within the City of Burbank**. A roll call vote indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. The Chair declared the motion carried. Voting Aye: Alderman Grider, Foy, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle and Pacella.
